### ACTIVITY AREA NOTES

The capacity for each activity area is firm due to accreditation restrictions, GSUSA ratio restrictions or equipment restrictions. Large rental groups should plan on scheduling activities multiple times throughout their stay for activities with smaller capacities to accommodate activity capacities. To ensure we can accommodate your requested activities, *reservations must be made 3 weeks in advance. Please allow 5 business days for your activity to be confirmed. Some activity availability is dependent upon weather.*

Please note that renting areas of the camp property does NOT include access to certain activity areas. Most activity areas and use of equipment in those areas is an add-on to the normal rental cost, and groups must provide their own certified adults to supervise the activities, unless noted otherwise.

Please note that most waterfront and pool activities require a Lifeguard. The ratio of lifeguards to swimmers is 1:25. If you have a large rental group, only 25 people may be participating in lakefront or pool activities at a time unless the rental group has multiple Lifeguards that meet the requirements of those activities. When filling out the rental application, if you have certified adults, you may use the pool at no additional charge and receive a discount on waterfront activities. Please submit the certifications required for the activities the group is requesting if you.

For instructional swimming activities, the rental group must always provide a Lifeguard on deck, beyond the swim instructor.

<p><b>Rock Wall</b></p> <p>The Gathering Hall at Trivera features a large artificial rock wall. All gear that is used must be provided by Camp Trivera, no personal gear is permitted. 10 participants – 1-1/2 hours total; ½ hour for each additional 5 participants. <b>Certified Adult is required to run your activity. Reservations must be made 3 weeks in advance. Please allow 5 business days for your activity to be confirmed.</b></p>		25 Grades 2-12, ages 7+ (no Daisies)	2 hours	\$7 per person	\$10 per person
<p><b>Canoeing</b></p> <p>Brownies through Ambassadors can participate without an adult in their canoe. Daisies can participate only if an adult is in a boat with them. An adult certified as an American Red Cross Lifeguard with the Waterfront module is required to lead the activity (must be out on the water with the participants), and all participants are required to wear lifejackets, regardless of swimming ability. As an ACA accredited camp, participants must use the paddles, PFD's, boats and safety gear provided by Trivera; personal gear and boats are not permitted. User groups are required to provide watchers at all water activities-please review Safety Activity Checkpoints for the required ratios. 6 participants – 1-1/2 hours total. <b>Certified Adult is required to run your activity. Reservations must be made 3 weeks in advance. Please allow 5 business days for your activity to be confirmed.</b></p>		12 Grades K-12, ages 5+	1-1/2 hours	Base + \$7 per person	Base + \$10 per person
<p><b>Sling Shot</b></p> <p>For Girl Scouts, Sling Shot serves as a progression step for target range activities like archery by teaching the girls about following range rules and commands as well as helping them to build aim, target skills, and hand-eye coordination. As an ACA accredited camp, participants may not bring/use their own gear – all gear used must be provided by Trivera. One adult needs to be a certified USA Archery instructor or have equivalent certification or documented experience according to your council guidelines. Ratio – 1:5 D, B; 1:10 J+ <b>Certified Adult is required to run your activity. Reservations must be made 3 weeks in advance. Please allow 5 business days for your activity to be confirmed.</b></p>		Grades 2-12, ages 7+ (no Daisies)	2 hours	\$5 per person	\$7 per person
<p><b>Zip Line</b></p> <p>The zip line is a great opportunity to see the lake and the zoo from a totally new perspective! All gear that is used must be provided by Camp Trivera, no personal gear is permitted. 10 participants – 1-1/2 hours. <b>Certified Council or Zoo Staff is required to run your activity. Reservations must be made 3 weeks in advance. Please allow 5 business days for your activity to be confirmed.</b></p>		Grades 2-12, ages 7+ (no Daisies)	2 hours	\$15 per person	\$20 per person
<p><b>Fishing</b></p> <p>All Girl Scout levels can participate in Fishing on the lake at Camp Trivera. An adult who is certified as an American Red Cross Basic Water Rescuer OR American Red Cross Lifeguard with the Waterfront module is required to always supervise the activity. Adults who are fishing are required to have a current fishing license issued by the correct governing body. Fishing poles and line are provided, any desired bait must be provided by the participants. <b>Certified Adult is required to run your activity. Reservations must be made 3 weeks in advance. <p align="center"><b>Pool Swimming</b></p> <p>Swimming at the Camp Trivera pool requires one adult certified as an American Red Cross Lifeguard for every 25 swimmers. Beyond 25 swimmers requires additional certified Lifeguards. Group must follow ratio requirements outlined by the American Red Cross. User groups are required to provide watchers at all water activities-please review Safety Activity Checkpoints for the required ratios. The pool is typically open from late April to the last week of September, weather permitting. The pool is not heated. <b>Up to 25 participants – 2 hours total. Certified Lifeguards are required to run your activity. <i>Reservations must be made 3 weeks in advance. Please allow 5 business days for your activity to be confirmed.</i></b></p>		25 Grades K-12, ages 5+	2 hours	\$5/person; \$50 minimum	\$7/person; \$70 minimum
<p align="center"><b>Cookout Equipment</b></p> <p>Chuck boxes are somewhat-mobile boxes of cookout equipment. They come with the following items: 1 large pot, 1 small pot, tongs, 2 frying pans, cookie sheet, cutting boards, eating utensils, plates/bowls, serving utensils, can opener, spatulas, a pitcher, dish soap, and a few other items. No food items are provided (no spices, oils, etc.). Chuck boxes can accommodate up to 12 people.</p>		Grades K-12, ages 5+	2 hours	\$20 per box	\$30 per box

Groups are responsible for cleaning all equipment before returning and completing a pre and post kit survey.
